Dear Athletes:

The Wisconsin Figure Skating Club (WFSC) Scholarship Committee is pleased to announce that applications are now being accepted for the 2020 Gale and Tom Tanger Scholarship.

The Tanger Scholarship Fund was created to provide financial aid to a Scholar-Athlete from the Wisconsin Figure Skating Club. The scholar-athlete must be a graduating high school senior student. The funds are generated from the profits of the annual Skate Milwaukee Competition. In 2009 the Board of Directors of the Wisconsin Figure Skating Club (WFSC) voted to establish this fund in the name of Gale and Tom Tanger, founders of the Skate Milwaukee competition. The award of the scholarship will be determined by a three to five-member review committee.

The Gale and Tom Tanger Scholarship is a *merit* based scholarship. This scholarship is not based on need. It is created as a cash award/recognition to a selected recipient(s). Candidates may apply through an online application form found on the WFSC web-site. This scholarship is open to home club members of the Wisconsin Figure Skating Club who have met all the selection criteria.

Criteria to be met by the applicant will include, but not limited to, the following:

- 1) Academic Excellence
- 2) Acceptance and full-time enrollment into a major college or university
- 3) Athletic distinction
- 4) Extracurricular and volunteer activities.
- 5) Volunteer 8 hours at Skate Milwaukee. (Past or present year)

The award will be announced by April 18 and will be presented at the annual WFSC Banquet. The committee will make every attempt to acknowledge each recipient in person at the Scholarship Recognition Assembly or Program at the recipient's school.

The application and all supporting materials must be fully completed and postmarked by March 31, 2020, or the applicant will not be considered. All materials must be sent to: Thomas Tanger, Scholarship Chair. Any questions regarding the application may be emailed to tgtanger@gmail.com.

Instructions for Completing Application

- Applicants must meet the following criteria:
 - Be an eligible skater and current member of U.S. Figure Skating.
 - Be a member of the Wisconsin Figure Skating Club a **minimum of 5 years**.
 - Be a full-time student entering the senior year of high school in the fall of 2019. Applicant must be enrolled in a fully accredited secondary school, attend classes and carry at least the minimum number of credit hours necessary to be a full-time student.
 - Maintain at least a 3.0 GPA (based on a 4.0 scale) or 85% (based on a 100% scale) during the last **two** years
- Applicant must complete and submit the following by the due date:
 - Official 2020 Gale and Tom Tanger Scholarship application. Application may be neatly handwritten or typed, but the essay **MUST** be typed.
 - An **Official Copy** of a high school transcript including grades through the last reporting period. Transcript **must be mailed; faxes or copies will not be accepted**. Transcripts can either be mailed separately or together with the rest of the items requested. **But all items must be received by March 31, 2020.**
 - SAT/ACT test results to the extent available.
 - The essay should be **no more than 250 words and must be typed.**
 - Three letters of recommendation are required: two academic related, and one service related.
(Recommendation letters **should not come** from **relatives or skating coaches** of the applicant.)
- The completed **application form** and **all supporting documents must be postmarked by March 31, 2020. No exceptions will be made.**
