Wisconsin Figure Skating Club Policy

Skating Professional Criteria

Wisconsin Figure Skating Club Professionals must meet the following criteria for ice privileges each year:

- Must have existing privileges on WFSC club ice
- Must be USFS green light coach confirmed on USFS website
- Must have a signed WFSC Coaches Code of Conduct on file

Ice privileges for NEW coaches will be considered upon the submission of the following documentation to the WFSC board and confirmation thereof:

- Resume
- Green light coach confirmed on USFS website
- Letter of recommendation from a current approved WFSC professional
- Must have a current coach application

Provisional ice privileges will be granted to new applicants meeting the criteria above. Within a 90 day provisional period, the WFSC coach committee will recommend status to the WFSC board for consideration, and the applicant will be approved or denied based on a majority of the WFSC board members.

The WFSC coach committee chair will be responsible for checking the USFS website annually to insure staff coaches are "green lighted"

LTS Instructors are not automatically provided Coaching privileges and must apply by the process above.
